


## Normalized Total Nonfarm Employment Trend (Seasonally-Adjusted)

#### Central Oregon Employment Change by Industry, April 2024 to April 2025





#### **Annual Hiring Level in Oregon**



# Decline in labor leverage ratio indicates looser labor market


- The relationship between quits and layoffs is a proxy for how confident each side of the labor market is (employers and employees)
- A higher ratio indicates more employee confidence, and vice versa









#### Nearly One in Four Bend MSA Jobs is Held By A Worker Aged 55 or Older

U.S Average Effective Tariff Rate Since 1790





#### Exports as a share of gross state product, 2024







Figure 1: Share of direct, indirect, and induced jobs supported by international trade by county


