




Graph of the Month: Job openings as a percent of employment in Oregon and the United States rose from about 5.8% in February 2021 to highs of 7.9% in Oregon (January 2023) and 7.4% nationally (March 2022), and has since declined to 4.8% in Oregon and 4.5% in the U.S. as of February.

- Oregon's openings rate has consistently exceeded the national rate by roughly 0.3 points.
- In February, Oregon had one unemployed person per job opening, compared with 0.9 nationally. The labor market is loosening, but remains tight.


Unemployment in Washington County at its highest since July 2021—up to 4.2% from 3.6% last year. January 2000 to March 2025, seasonally adjusted

Employment in Washington County has increased by +5,700 from February 2020 to March 2025.




