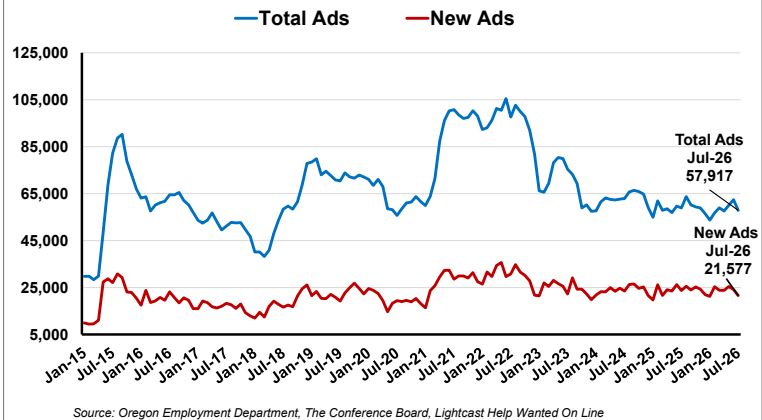

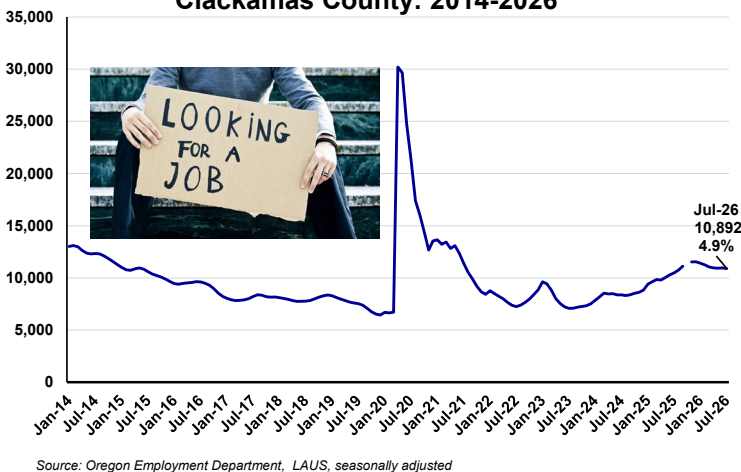
Graph of the Month: Help wanted online job ads measure online job ad volume over time, showing the demand for workers.

- The Portland MSA had 57,917 total job ads in July, down by -1,026 from a year ago. Clackamas County had 8,770 total ads in July, down by -1,160 from a year ago.
- The number of ads posted for the first time (new ads) in the Portland MSA reached 21,577 In July, down by -2,165 ads from a year ago.
- Online job ads peaked during the two years following the pandemic recession in 2021-2022 but have now fallen to pre-pandemic levels.

Not Seasonally Adjusted

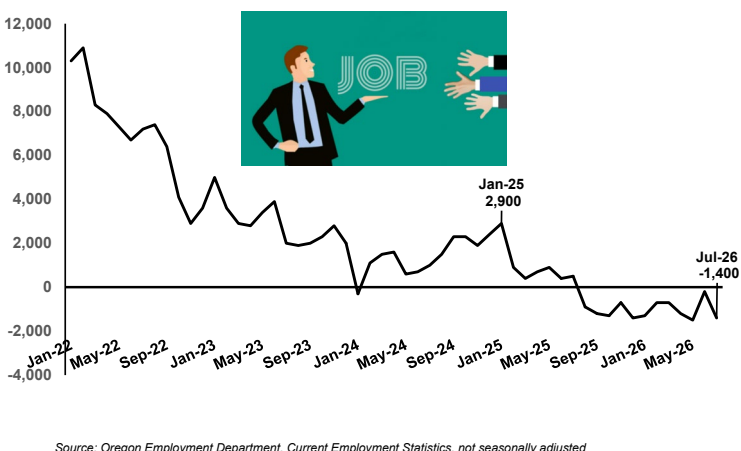


Number of Unemployed Residents
Clackamas County: 2014-2026

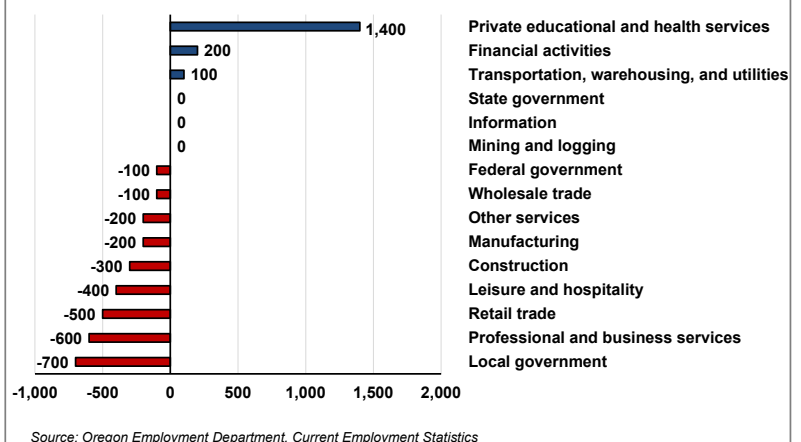


- The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Clackamas County was 4.9% in July – unchanged from the previous month with 10,892 unemployed workers living in the county.
- Covered employment in Clackamas County reached 172,400 in July, a decrease of -2,000 jobs from the previous month and a decrease of -1,400 jobs from a year ago.
- Clackamas County lost a net total of -1,400 jobs from June 2025 to July 2026. Most broad industries had negative job growth with private educational and health services adding the most jobs (+1,400).
