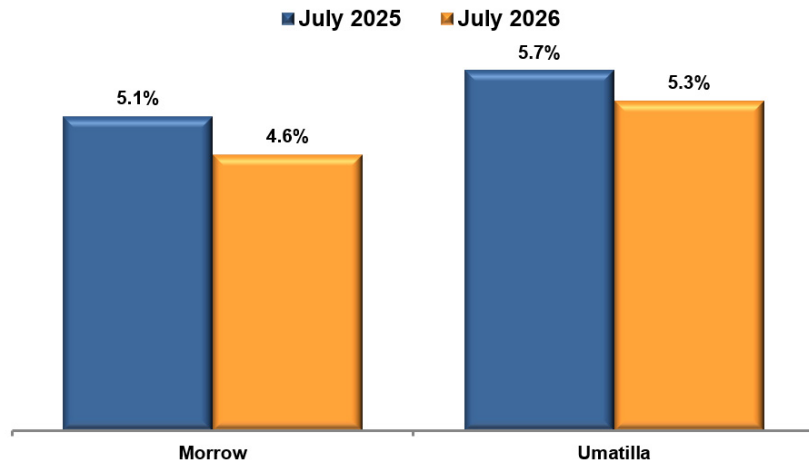


Unemployment Rates (Seasonally Adjusted)

Nonfarm Employment Change

July 2025 to July 2026

Morrow County gained an estimated 90 jobs over the year. The private sector increased by 130 jobs and the public sector lost 40 jobs. The most notable job gains over the year came from construction and manufacturing. The largest losses were shared by transportation, warehousing, and utilities, and local government.

Umatilla County lost an estimated 40 jobs over the year. The private sector decreased by 80 jobs and the public sector increased by 40 positions. Information, and private education and health services largely led gains. The most notable losses came from accommodation and food services, and retail trade.

Unemployment Rate

Morrow County's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for July 2026 showed a slight increase of 0.1 percentage point from the previous month, while Umatilla County's rate remained the same.

Oregon's statewide seasonally adjusted unemployment rate of 5.2% fell between the two counties' rates. Both Morrow and Umatilla counties were above the national rate of 4.1%.

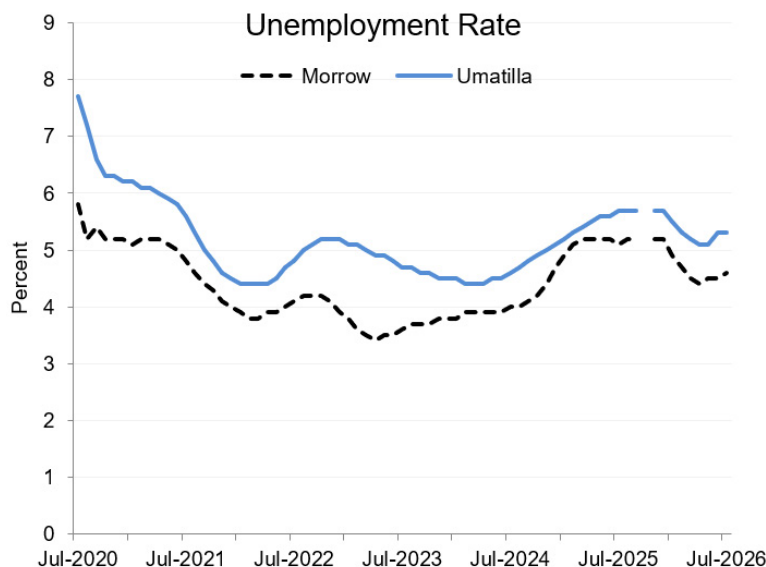
