




- Total nonfarm employment reached 169,100 in February which was 100 less jobs than the previous month and 3,100 more than a year ago.
- The unemployment rate (seasonally adjusted)
 reached 4.0% in February from 3.7% a year ago.
 There were 9,124 unemployed residents in Clackamas County in February which was 624 more than a year ago.
- Since the recession, the county has added back 25,100 jobs with the majority of growth in leisure and hospitality, and professional and business services.







The population in Clackamas County has grown by 48,741 or by 12.8% in the past decade.

- Clackamas County's population reached 430,421 in 2022 adding 48,741 residents from 2012-2022.
- The incorporated cities in Clackamas County that added the most residents from 2012-2022 included Happy Valley (11,724), Wilsonville (6,899), Oregon City (5,286), and Lake Oswego (4,378).
- The cities that grew the fastest in the last decade included Estacada (88.5%), and Happy Valley (78.3%). Slowest population growth was seen in Milwaukie (4.3%) and Gladstone (5.9%).
