



Clackamas County ECONOMIC INDICATORS

January 2025 (December data)

Graph of the Month: How do Women's Wages Compare to Men's Wages in Clackamas County?

- During 2023 in Clackamas County, women earned an average monthly wage of \$5,010 in all industry sectors compared to \$6,746 for men — earning 74% of men's wages on average.
- When considering wages by specific industry sectors, the percentage of women's wages to men's varied from a high of 96% in admin and support to as low as 65% in finance and insurance.
- Women's average wage (all industry sectors) as a portion of men's has increased from 61% in 2000 to 74% in 2023, or by 13 percentage points.



- The *seasonally adjusted* unemployment rate in Clackamas County during December increased slightly to 3.9% from 3.8% the previous month. The number of residents who were unemployed in the county reached 8,826 in December — an increase of 207 from the previous month.
- Total nonfarm employment in Clackamas County reached 175,200 in December with year-over-year employment growth at 3,900. The majority of job growth was in private education and health services (1,900); local government (1,100); leisure and hospitality (700); and financial activities (400). Job losses were seen in construction (-400); information (-100); and federal government (-100).
