

Graph of the Month: Business startup rates unexpectedly rose in the period after the 2020 COVID pandemic, after decades of low business formation rates relative to population. According to the U.S. Census Bureau's Business Formation Statistics, Lane County had over 4,000 new business applications in 2023, an increase of 90% over the level in 2005.
