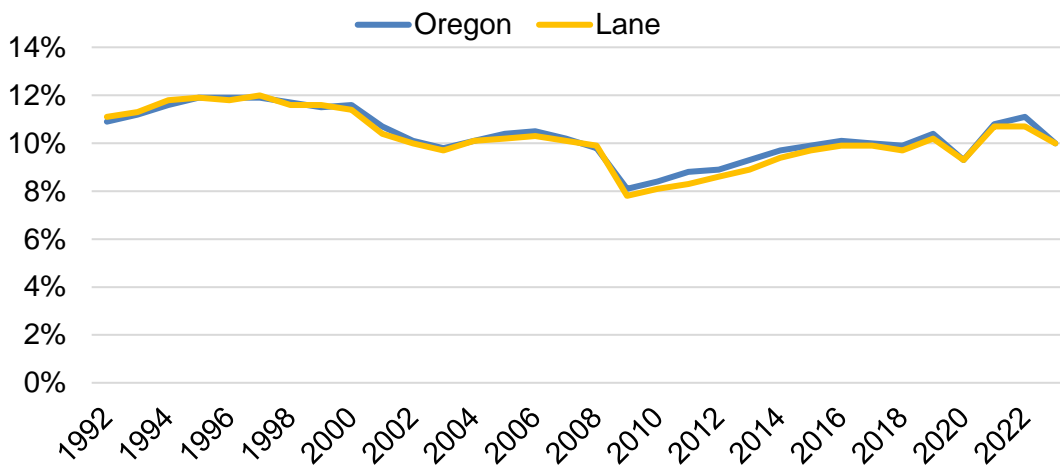


LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

Graph of the Month: The rate at which people leave their jobs tends to go up when the labor market is tighter as workers increase their confidence about finding a new opportunity. In both Oregon and Lane County, turnover decreased in 2023, although the rate is higher than 2008 or 2020.
