

Special Topic: Q1 Manufacturing Subsector Snapshot



Across Oregon wood product manufacturing is a large employer within the manufacturing sector. This past quarter the subsector employed 537 workers and paid an average quarterly wage of \$13,460. This subsector alone accounts for approximately 19% of the manufacturing workforce.

Miscellaneous manufacturing and transportation equipment manufacturing are two other large employers in the sector. Miscellaneous manufacturing is a comprehensive group of businesses that aren't easily classified as other types of manufacturers.


The manufacturing sector overall comprises about 10.4% of the workforce in all privately owned companies in Josephine county.



Food manufacturing and transportation equipment manufacturing are two other large employers in the sector. These two subsectors represented another 25.1% of the manufacturing workforce.


The manufacturing sector overall comprised about 8.4% of the workforce in all privately owned companies in Jackson county.


