

Special Topic: Veteran and Nonveteran Unemployment



The veteran unemployment rate in Jackson County has been decreasing since 2012. Veteran unemployment was at a high in 2012 at 14.4%. Over a 10-year period unemployment has decreased by 11.6 percentage points to 2.8% in 2022.


After 2017 the veteran population saw lower levels of unemployment relative to nonveterans. Nonveteran unemployment decreased by 6.4 percentage points from a high of 12% in 2012 to a low of 5.6% in 2022.

The differences between veteran and nonveteran unemployment rates was statistically significant in 2022.


Unemployment Rate at 4.6%

- Unemployment rate in October 2023 was 4.5%
- Seasonally adjusted unemployment rate has been relatively stable since early 2024



Special Topic: Veteran and Nonveteran Unemployment



The veteran unemployment rate in Josephine County decreased from 2012 to 2017 and increased slightly thereafter. Veteran unemployment was at a high in 2012 at 16.8%. Over a 10-year period unemployment has decreased by 7.9 percentage points to 8.9% in 2022.


In 2017 the nonveteran population experienced higher levels of unemployment relative to veterans. Nonveteran unemployment decreased by 5.6 percentage points from a high of 13.2% in 2012 to a low of 7.6% in 2022.

The differences between these rates was not statistically significant in any of the years highlighted.


Unemployment Rate at 5.6%
