

Special Topic: Private Firm Size Distribution

The vast majority of private firms in Jackson County have fewer than five employees as of July 2020. These 5,219 firms made up 70.4% of all firms and employed 5,763 workers. At the other end of the size spectrum there were 214 firms with 50 employees or more which were 1.3% of all firms that added 37,296 jobs.


The average guarterly wage paid out by firms with fewer than five employees was \$12,870. Larger firms in the 500+ employee category paid around \$10,000 more compared to these smaller firms. Large firms paid an average quarterly wage of \$22,890.



Industry Employment Change: Nov 2023 to Nov 2024 Jackson County employment declined by 90 jobs over the year



Special Topic: Private Firm Size Distribution


The vast majority of private firms in Josephine County have fewer than five employees as of July 2020. These 1,725 firms made up 71.3% of all firms and employed 1,966 workers. At the other end of the size spectrum there were 63 firms with 50 employees or more which were 2.6% of all firms that added 11,686 jobs.

There was not a significant difference in the average quarterly wages paid out by smaller firms compared to larger firms. Firms with fewer than five employees paid an average quarterly wage of \$10,660. Firms with 250-500 employees paid an average quarterly wage of \$10,540.


Unemployment Rate at 5.6%
