


This graph depicts a six year snapshot of retail employment in Jackson County during the month of December when retail employment is typically at its highest. This past December retail employment decreased by 430 jobs compared to December 2023, a modest loss. In December 2024 the retail sector accounted for 15.1% of all nonfarm employment in Jackson County.


Retail employment ranged from a low of 13,660 in 2024 to a high of 15,200 in 2019. Employment levels in this sector have been declining year over year. Statewide the sector reached a new high in April 2022 but has since been declining.

- Seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was +/- 0.2% over the year ranging from 4.7% to 4.9%




This graph depicts a six year snapshot of retail employment in Josephine County during the month of December when retail employment is typically at its highest. This past December retail employment decreased by 10 jobs compared to December 2023, a modest loss. In December 2024 the retail sector accounted for 15.3% of all nonfarm employment in Josephine County.

During this time period retail employment ranged from a low of 4,170 in 2024 to a high of 4,370 in 2022. Employment levels now are below what they were during the COVID-19 pandemic. Statewide the sector reached a new high in April 2022 but has since been declining.


