



Graph of the Month: The percentage of older workers in Washington County has more than doubled from 10.6% in 2000 to 22.3% In 2023.

- The actual number of older workers (55+ years) in Washington County increased by 47,551 workers or by 193% from 2000-2023.
- Since 2000, the percentage of all other age groups employed in Washington County have fallen with the exception of the 45-54 age group which slightly increased from 20.9 to 21.3% from 2000-2023.




Employment in Washington County increased by 600 jobs from April 2024 to May 2024.
