


Graph of the Month: Year-over-year change in the "food at home" price index shot up by 12.8 percentage points from May 2021 to August 2022.

- Year-to-year change in the consumer price for "food at home" increased from 0.7% in May 2021 to a high of 13.5% in August 2022.
- Change in the CPI for all items excluding food at home was significantly lower during a similar time period at 5.5% in May 2021 to a high of 8.8% in June 2022.
- The year-to-year change in the price of "food at home" in August has now fallen to 0.9%.


