




Graph of the Month: Recently released **2023** data shows that the county's **personal income percapita** gap over the state varies overtime and has held at 17% from 2022 to 2023, after peaking at 21% in 2018.



- Washington County: \$79,139 (+5.3% y-o-y).
- Multnomah County: \$75,772 (+5.5% y-o-y).
- Clackamas County: \$80,269 (+5.9% y-o-y).

Unemployment in Washington County at its highest since February 2023—Still lowest in Portland MSA. January 2000 to December 2024, seasonally adjusted






Employment in Washington County reached 313,600 in December; the county gained +1,500 over the year.
