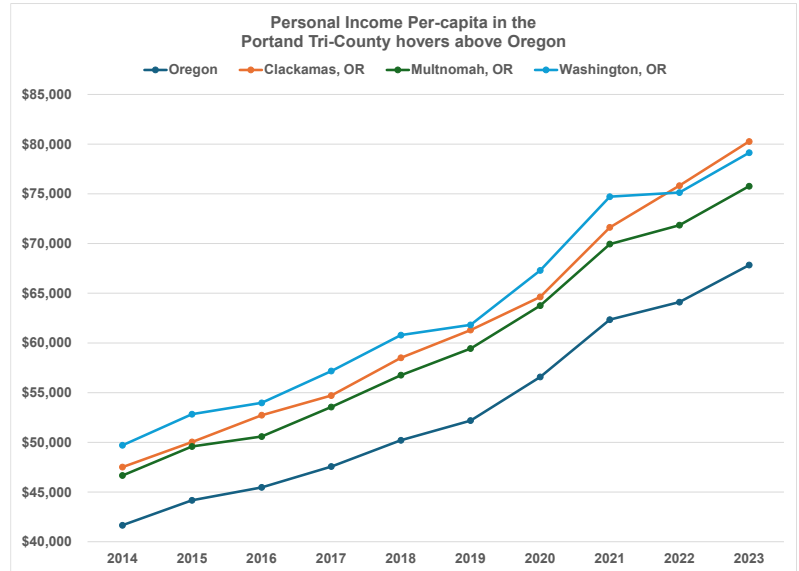
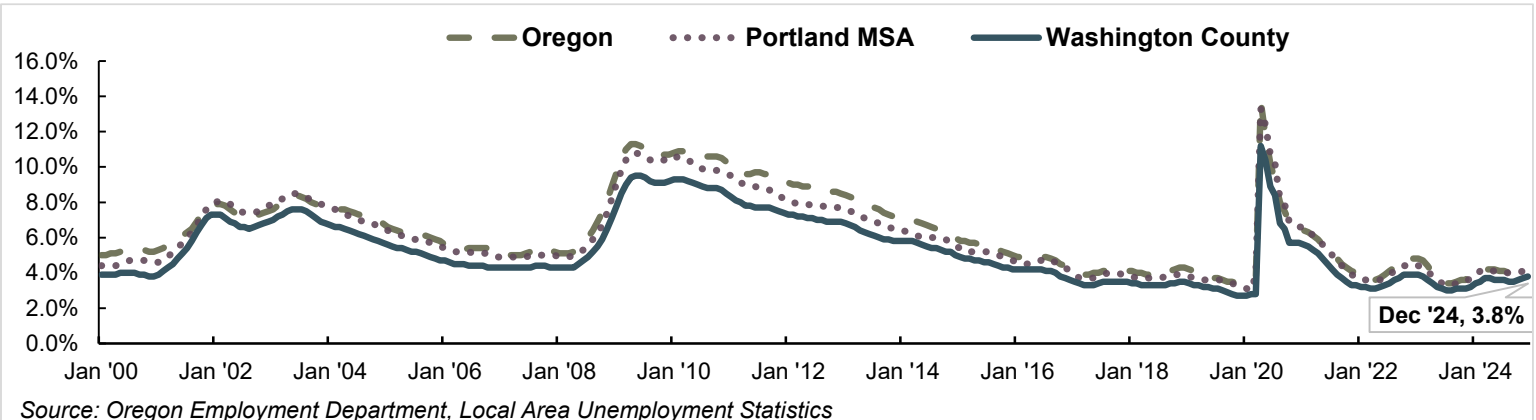


**Graph of the Month:** Recently released 2023 data shows that the county's **personal income per-capita** gap over the state varies overtime and has held at 17% from 2022 to 2023, after peaking at 21% in 2018.

- **Oregon:** \$67,838 (+5.8% year-over-year).
- **Washington County:** \$79,139 (+5.3% y-o-y).
- **Multnomah County:** \$75,772 (+5.5% y-o-y).
- **Clackamas County:** \$80,269 (+5.9% y-o-y).



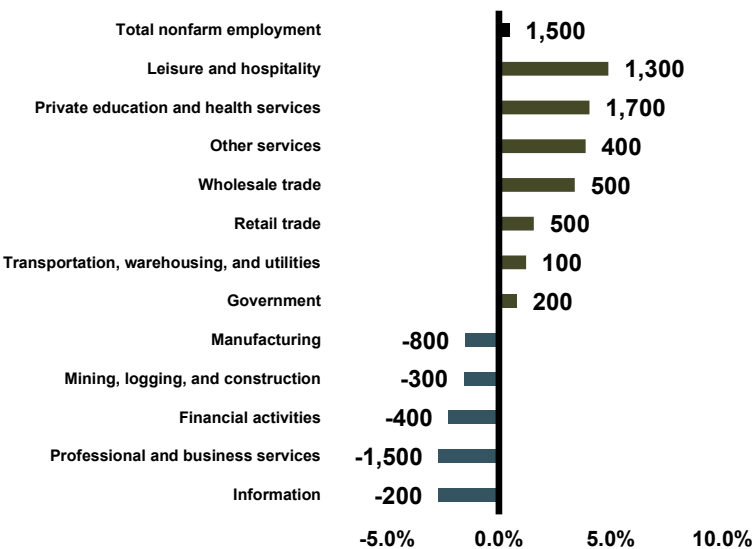
**Unemployment in Washington County at its highest since February 2023—Still lowest in Portland MSA.** January 2000 to December 2024, *seasonally adjusted*



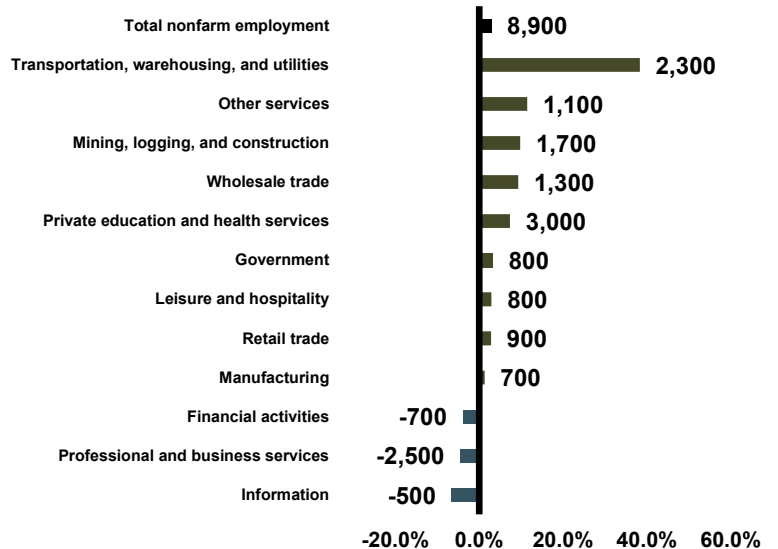
**Employment in Washington County reached 313,600 in December; the county gained +1,500 over the year.**
