# Economic Indicators January 2023 (December 2022 Data)

Washington County's unemployment rate continued ticking up slightly to 3.5% in December. This is on par with the December 2021 rate of 3.5% and below the 20-year average rate of 5.7%.

Washington saw strong and broad yearly job growth, with most sectors staying above pre-pandemic levels. Only financial activities and retail trade saw any notable decline. Month to month, job numbers were relatively unchanged, with most gains in trade, transportation, and utilities, and small losses in construction.


While unemployment rates have increased throughout Oregon, Washington County continues to remain amongst the regions with the lowest unemployment rates in the State. In December, the average rate for the Portland MSA increased to 4%, while the statewide rate increased to 4.5%. Washington County continues to remain half a percent lower than the Portland MSA at 3.5%. One driver for this difference in unemployment rates is the strong recovery the leisure and hospitality sector has seen in the area, compared with the recovery of the sector in Multnomah.

### While Unemployment Rates Increase Statewide, Washington County Continues to Rank Among the Lowest


