HELP WANTED IN THE PORTLAND-METRO AREA

RESULTS FROM THE 2024 JOB VACANCY SURVEY

FEBRUARY 2025



PORTLAND METRO HAD ROUGHLY 16,900 JOB VACANCIES AT ANY GIVEN TIME IN 2024.

We surveyed 1,900 private employers with two or more employees.

If they were hiring, employers gave details about each vacancy, including:

- Job title
- Full- or part-time status
- Permanent or temporary status
- Starting wage or salary
- Education and experience requirements

Businesses also identified if their vacancies were difficult to fill, and if so, they wrote in the primary reason they faced hiring challenges.

The number of Oregon job vacancies declined from 2023 to 2024, matching the level seen in 2019 prior to the pandemic recession.

A typical job vacancy tends to be for a full-time, permanent position. 39% require education beyond high school and 55% require previous experience.




Portland Metro Job Vacancies by Education Requirement, 2024





AVERAGE HOURLY WAGES INCREASE ALONG WITH EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR JOB VACANCIES...


Average Hourly Wage for Portland Metro Job Vacancies by Education Requirement, 2024


Share of Portland Metro Job Vacancies Requiring Education Beyond High School by Hourly Wage Range, 2024


