
### December 2023 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In December, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 17 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in 19. Fifteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide and U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%.

Crook County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate (5.7%) in December. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Lake (5.0%), Josephine (4.9%), and Klamath (4.9%). Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in December at 2.7%. Other counties with relatively low unemployment rates included Hood River (3.0%), Benton (3.2%), and Washington (3.2%).

## Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between December 2022 and December 2023, total nonfarm employment rose in all six broad regions across Oregon. Central Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 4.1%. Employment grew at a relatively moderate pace along the Coast (2.4%), in the Willamette Valley (1.8%), in the five Portland-metro counties (1.7%), and in Eastern Oregon (1.7%). Growth was slowest in Southern Oregon (1.3%).
