
May 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In May, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 32 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in four. Seventeen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.2% and thirteen had rates at or below the U.S. unemployment rate of 4.0%.

Crook County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in May at 6.3%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine and Klamath, both at 5.4%. Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in May at 3.1%. Other counties with relatively low unemployment rates included Hood River (3.2%) and Benton (3.4%).

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between May 2023 and May 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in three of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in three. Eastern Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.6%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in the Willamette Valley (1.5%). Employment grew at a moderate pace in Central Oregon (0.5%). Employment decreased in Southern Oregon by -0.1%. Employment also decreased in the five Portland-metro counties (-0.3%) and along the Coast (-0.4%).

Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
