
June 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In June, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 35 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in Grant County. Seventeen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide and U.S. unemployment rate of 4.1%.

Crook County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in June at 6.1%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine and Klamath, both at 5.4%. Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in June at 3.0%. Other counties with relatively low unemployment rates included Hood River (3.2%) and Benton (3.3%).

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between June 2023 and June 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in three of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in three. Eastern Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.7%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in the Willamette Valley (1.4%). Employment grew at a moderate pace in Southern Oregon (0.6%). Employment decreased in Central Oregon by -0.2%. Employment also decreased in the five Portland-Metro counties (-0.4%) and along the Coast (-1.0%).

Employed includes nonfarm payroll employment, self-employed, unpaid family workers, domestics, agriculture, and labor disputants. Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
