
July 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In July, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 23 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in thirteen. Seventeen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.1% and nineteen had rates at or below the U.S. unemployment rate of 4.3%.

Crook County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in July at 6.0%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine (5.5%), Curry (5.4%), and Klamath (5.4%). Hood River and Wheeler counties registered the lowest unemployment rate in July, both at 3.1%. Benton County also had a relatively low unemployment rate at 3.2%.

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between July 2023 and July 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in three of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in three. The Willamette Valley experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.6%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in Central Oregon (1.3%). Employment grew at a moderate pace in Southern Oregon (0.7%). Employment decreased in the five Portland-Metro counties by -0.3%. Employment also decreased in Eastern Oregon (-0.8%) and along the Coast (-1.7%).

Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
