
September 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In September, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 30 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in six. Sixteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.0% and eighteen had rates at or below the U.S. rate of 4.1%.

Crook and Grant counties had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rates in September, both with rates of 5.7%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine (5.5%) and Klamath (5.4%). Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in September at 3.0%. Hood River and Benton counties also had relatively low unemployment rates, at 3.1% and 3.2%, respectively.

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between September 2023 and September 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in three of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in three. The Willamette Valley experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.0%. Employment also grew at a moderate pace in Southern Oregon (0.5%) and

Central Oregon (0.4%). Employment decreased in the five Portland-Metro counties by 0.3%. Employment also decreased in Eastern Oregon (-0.6%) and along the Coast (-1.7%).

Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
