
### October 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In October, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 16 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in 20. Fifteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.0% and seventeen had rates at or below the U.S. rate of 4.1%.

Grant County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in October at 5.9%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Crook (5.6%), Josephine (5.6%), and Klamath (5.5%). Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in October at 3.0%. Hood River and Benton counties also had relatively low unemployment rates, at 3.2% and 3.3%, respectively.

## Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between October 2023 and October 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in five of Oregon's six broad regions and was unchanged in one. Central Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 2.5%. Employment also grew at a moderate pace in the Willamette Valley at 1.2%. Employment growth was slow along the Coast (0.4%), in the five Portland-Metro counties (0.2%), and in Eastern Oregon (0.1%). Employment was unchanged in Southern Oregon.
