
November 2024 Employment and Unemployment in Oregon's Counties

In November, unemployment rates decreased or remained unchanged in 28 of Oregon's 36 counties over the month and increased in eight. Eighteen counties had unemployment rates at or below the statewide rate of 4.1% and nineteen had rates at or below the U.S. rate of 4.2%.

Grant County had Oregon's highest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in November at 6.0%. Other counties with relatively high unemployment rates were Josephine (5.6%), Crook (5.5%), and Klamath (5.5%). Wheeler County registered the lowest unemployment rate in November at 3.0%. Hood River and Benton counties also had relatively low unemployment rates, at 3.2% and 3.4%, respectively.

Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate






Oregon Employment Department, Local Area Unemployment Statistics

Between November 2023 and November 2024, total nonfarm employment rose in five of Oregon's six broad regions and decreased in one. Central Oregon experienced the fastest job growth over the year at 1.9%. Employment also grew relatively quickly in the Willamette Valley at 1.7%. Employment growth was slower along the Coast (0.7%), in the five Portland-Metro counties (0.6%), and in Eastern Oregon (0.2%). Employment decreased by 0.2% in Southern Oregon.

Employed includes nonfarm payroll employment, self-employed, unpaid family workers, domestics, agriculture, and labor disputants. Unemployment rate is calculated by dividing unemployed by civilian labor force. Data are not seasonally adjusted unless otherwise noted.
