


The number of U.S. Help Wanted Online ads was 4.6 million in April.

 - California: 688,500




The number of online ads in Oregon was 82,600 in April. The number of new ads decreased by 7,100 over the month.










The number of online ads in the Portland metro area was 49,300 in April. The number of new ads decreased by 5,860 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Salem metro area was 12,300 in April. The number of new ads decreased by 1,140 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Eugene metro area was 6,500 in April. The number of new ads decreased by 980 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Medford metro area was 2,700 in April. The number of new ads increased by 60 over the month.




The number of online ads in the Bend metro area was 2,600 in April. The number of new ads decreased by 60 over the month.












Mid-Valley Help Wanted Online Ads


Lane Help Wanted Online Ads


East Cascades Help Wanted Online Ads








