






Wage Growth Outpacing Inflation, Not a Major Source of Inflation






Unemployment Rate Recoveries Across OR-5 PMSA Counties (Feb 2020 - Sep 2024)

Oregon CPS U-6 Components [Trend]






Labor Force Participation Rate Has Been High Since the Pandemic, Increasing Recently






Washington County % Change in Employment by Broad Sector (Feb 2020 to Sep 2024)





Washington County % Change in Employment (Feb 2020 to Sep 2024)





Job Openings with Private Employers, 2013-2024






Portland Tri-County Industry Projections, 2022-2032

Portland Tri-County Occupational Projections, 2022-2032



Number of households moving into the state minus the number moving out of the state





Number of Oregon residents, all ages


Baseline Forecast | Zero Migration Scenario




PMSA Home Median Listing Price: Similar trend as national over the last few years





New Privately Owned Housing Units Authorized by County: Oregon 2023










Washington County, Oregon 2023
